4 CHALLENGES

Healthcare System Resilience:

- COVID-19
 pandemic exposed
 vulnerabilities in
 European
 healthcare
 systems.
- Weaknesses include underinvestment, short-term savings, and inefficient healthcare models.

Collaboration and Co-Creation:

- Insufficient level of collaboration among innovation actors, limited co-creation and joint ideation.
- Inefficient positioning in interregional context due to missing know-how and benchmarks.
- Lack of consulting assistance in matters related to the creation and implementation of innovations, intellectual property protection, international partner search.
- Lack of comprehensive understanding of EU value chains and their potentials.

Information and Knowledge Sharing:

- Lack of coherent and targeted, easily accessible information to discover innovation potentials and lighten the fuzzy front end of innovation.
- Complex process of preparing project applications for international calls, difficulties in finding international partners.
- Barriers in the legal, administrative, and institutional framework implementing RDI.
- Unrevealed potentials in terms of green and digital transition.

Access to Finance:

- · Gap in the validation of investment ideas.
- Lack of consistent support schemes that ensure uninterrupted opportunities to finance projects of R&D activities from the lowest to the highest stages of R&D and their synchronization between individual institutions.
- Since many companies in the sector carry out earlystage applied scientific research, they need long-term investments, but there is a great lack of such investments in the participating countries, and the investment period is usually shorter than the period required for the development of products in the health sector. There is an absence of mechanisms to encourage venture capital funds to invest in risky but strategically important projects.
- Absence of a long-term business and science partnership program of the sector.

OBJECTIVES

To focus on health innovation ecosystems to achieve the desired efficacy of the healthcare sector and to boost and sustain efficient international collaboration of the relevant quadruple helix innovation actors.

Specific objectives:

- SO1 Accelerate the development of validated innovation investments in the thematic focus areas of the project
- SO2 Enhance interregional cooperation and participation in EU value chains

- MDR compliance.


